WHAT IS IT?

Through the Health Information Exchange Connection Fee Assistance Program all Oklahoma providers can access funding for connecting their EHR to the state designated HIE, MyHealth. Although \$30 million is available to providers who apply now, funding beyond June 30, 2024, is not guaranteed. All eligible providers are encouraged to apply today.

WHY?

As providers, the ability to enhance coordination of care and improve patient outcomes is a top priority. The Connection Fee Assistance program offers financial incentives for HIE participation.
