WHAT IS IT?

Through the Health Information Exchange Connection Fee Assistance Program all Oklahoma providers can access funding for connecting their EHR/EMR to the state designated HIE, MyHealth. There is \$21 million available to providers who apply now. All eligible providers are encouraged to apply today.

WHY?

As providers, the ability to enhance coordination of care and improve patient outcomes is a top priority. The Connection Fee Assistance program offers financial incentives for HIE participation. Receive accurate and timely data, avoid costly redundant tests, and enable better resource allocation with MyHealth. Follow the 3 steps outlined here to join today!



STEP 1

Apply for MyHealth Access Network, Oklahoma's state designated health information exchange.
