

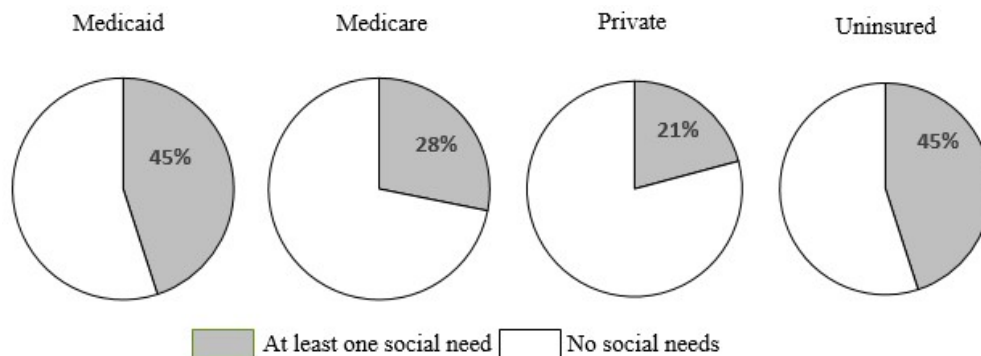


Accountable Health Communities

MyHealth Access Network is excited to share an update regarding the Accountable Health Communities project. **MyHealth is using a mobile screening technique** to identify beneficiaries' health related social needs (HRSNs) and provide real-time connections to resources to help meet their identified social needs.

The AHC project screens for HRSNs in the areas of housing quality and stability, food security, utility needs, transportation needs and interpersonal safety. The patient receives immediate feedback with a list of customized resources, as well as navigation services for high-risk Medicaid and Medicare patients. This project is made possible for Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries through a cooperative agreement with CMMI and for commercially insured and uninsured by MyHealth.

To date, we have found a significant portion of patients with all insurance types report social needs.

Additionally, this screening meets the **CPC+ requirement** to screen for social determinants of health and provides participating providers **credit toward their MIPS score** in the area of Quality Improvement.

This screening is now available STATEWIDE in Oklahoma.

We are excited about the statewide expansion of the project and are looking for additional clinical delivery sites to join this innovative social needs screening project. This process provides a valuable service to the patient with no additional cost or workload for the healthcare facility.
